Getting Started with Vericatch's ELOGS

Before setting up your ELOGS, please have the following information at hand:

- ELOG Key *see below for information on how to get this one-time-only identifier*
- Vessel Identification Number
- Your Apple ID and password or Android ID and password
- FIN
- Your email password
- License Number



STEP ONE

Sign Up for ELOGS on vericatch.com

Note: you must create an account on the Vericatch website before logging into the app. You can choose a two-week free trial or pay immediately.

Create your account

Go to the vericatch.com website and click the “sign up” button on the top right-hand side of the homepage menu. Sign up using your email address and choose a password you can remember, then confirm your password, agree to the terms of service, and hit the “sign up” button.

Confirm your account

Check your email account for an email with the subject line: *Vericatch: Welcome To Fisheries App: Next Steps*. If you do not see it within a few minutes, be sure to check your spam folder. Open the email and hit the “confirm your email” button. You will be taken back to the Vericatch website where you will have to log in again to continue your set up.

Select your ELOG type

Once you have signed back in, click the “Add Logbook” button in the top right of the screen and select your fishery type (ie. ELOG Lobster) and service level and complete payment:

Setup fishery

Click on the red “Setup Fishery” button, which will walk you through adding your:

- ELOG Key* & FIN
- Profile - Name & contact information
- Licenses & Preferences - Fishing license
- My Vessels - Vessel ID # and name number etc.

Your fishery set up is complete once all four circles are checked off.

**To set up your account and submit your data to the DFO, the Government of Canada requires that you acquire an ELOG Key. There is a link to retrieve your ELOG key in the “Setup Fisheries” process. Select this link, which will take you to a DFO page to get your ELOG Key. You will then be brought to the National Online Licensing System (NOLS). Log in to NOLS, and your ELOG key should be on the screen - it's a long series of numbers and letters. Write down your key or use the “Copy” function below the ELOG key, return to the Vericatch ELOG setup page, and type or paste your ELOG key into the required section. Note: this is a one-time step only per enterprise. You will never have to do this again.*

STEP TWO

Download and Login to FisheriesApp on Your Mobile Device

Download FisheriesApp

Go to the Apple App Store or Google Play Store on your phone or tablet, search for “Vericatch FisheriesApp,” and download the app.

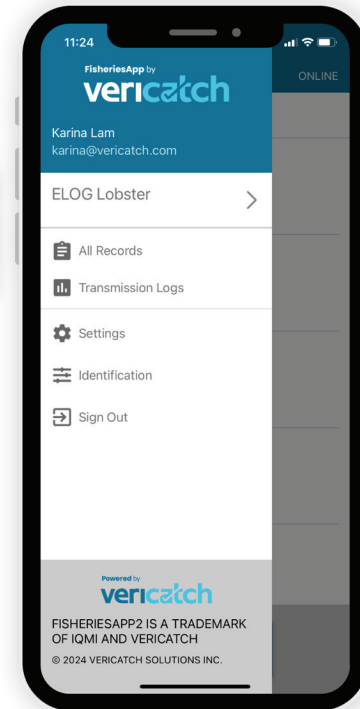


App login

Once you've downloaded the app, you can sign in using the login details you created in Step One, and your profile information will be filled in already. The first time you log in to the app it needs to sync in order to populate the material you have entered on the website. This may take a few minutes.

New trip log

Click on the name of the fishery you just created, and click on the blue “New Trip Log” button at the bottom of your screen to get started with your first trip.
